Re: RHS Band night – Friday, September 18th

The Eighth Grade members of the Barbara Bush Middle School Band Program have a required performance at the RHS football game on Friday, September 18th. Like most of our performances, this will be a graded performance. Please contact us immediately if you have a conflict.

We will ride school buses to Standridge Stadium and back to BBMS. The students will be able to carry their instruments in the back of one of the buses. We will sit with the RHS Band during the game and perform some of our music with them. We hope that you will be able to attend the game and support our band programs.

Tentative Schedule

- 5:30p The Bandroom will be open so the students can get their equipment ready. Students should sit in their assigned seat for **roll call**.
- 6:00p Load the buses and leave for Standridge Stadium
- 6:15p Unload the equipment and take the cases and music stands into the stadium.
- 6:45p The RHS band will march pre-game. We will sit and watch them perform.
National Anthem and pre-game activities (game starts at 7:30p).
- 8:30p After half-time - load up the equipment and move back to the bus, load up all equipment and go back to BBMS.
- 8:45p Parents will pick up students at BBMS

Any student that will be remaining at the stadium (instead of returning with the Band to BBMS) must give the Band Staff a note prior to Friday, September 18th, signed by one of the parents. If you allow your student to stay at the stadium, they will need to find someone to load and unload their instrument at the bandroom (large instruments only). Parents will need to pick up their student at the end of the game.

What the Students need for the Game

Band instrument and music.

The RHS Band is giving our students a Band shirt to wear. We'll give the shirt to the students on Thursday. The students should wear the RHS shirt, khaki shorts and tennis shoes.

The students will not need money for the concession stand (we won't take a break at the game).

We will need some chaperons for the bus ride over. They will also help out in the stadium where needed. The chaperons will **NOT** get into the game free (the cost is \$7). If you want to go, please contact me personally at the email address or phone number above.
