<b>Entering the room</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After entering the classroom, go directly to your assigned seat.</li> <li>• Students not in their assigned seats 5 seconds after the bell will be considered tardy.</li> <li>• Begin working on the warm-up in the notes section of your science notebook:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ date the problem(s)</li> <li>○ choose the best answer</li> <li>○ state reason for answer in a complete sentence, using supporting data</li> <li>○ write down the learning goal, activities and homework written on the board.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Classroom Policies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be properly prepared for class.</li> <li>• Exhibit respect for yourself, other students, and the teacher at all times.</li> <li>• Follow the Blalack Code of Conduct.</li> </ul>
<b>Presentation Expectations</b>	<p>During lectures, discussions, and demonstrations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please raise hand to ask questions.</li> <li>• Only have necessary/required materials on desk.</li> <li>• Please make no unnecessary noises, talking or visual distractions.</li> <li>• Do not leave your seat without permission.</li> </ul>
<b>Supply Requirements</b>	<p>To be brought to <b>every</b> class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Science Notebook with clean notebook paper or spiral notebook.</li> <li>• Pen (black or blue), pencil, and red grading pen/pencil</li> <li>• Something to read in case you complete your work early.</li> <li>• Materials and notes for ongoing projects to be worked on in class.</li> </ul>
<b>Off-Limits Areas</b>	<p>The supply room behind the class, all supply cabinets and the teacher's desk are off-limits to students unless permission is given.</p>
<b>Absence Policy</b>	<p>After returning from an absence, you should get any notes missed from another student or from the website. See the teacher during tutorials to get any missed work.</p>
<b>Late Work</b>	<p>You can turn an major grade assignment in late, up to 2 days after it was due, with a 10% grade penalty per class day late. Work will not be accepted more than 2 days late. Daily grade assignments and homework will not be accepted late.</p>
<b>Class Materials</b>	<p>No materials may be removed from the classroom without permission from the instructor. Textbooks may be checked out to each student at the beginning of the year. That student is responsible for keeping the text covered and in good condition. <i>Fines will be assessed for damages to the text.</i></p>
<b>Notebook requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be a 3-ring binder and have 4 tab dividers.</li> <li>• Must be neat, organized and kept up-to-date.</li> <li>• Must have a supply of clean notebook paper.</li> <li>• Hole reinforcement is highly suggested.</li> <li>• Will be graded <i>AT LEAST</i> once every quarter (9 weeks).</li> </ul>
